Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Jonathan Bianco – Cabinet Member for Property, Highways and Transport Councillor Martin Goddard – Cabinet Member for Finance
Decision	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance and the Cabinet Member for Finance, Property and Business Services agreed to a capital release request of £42k from the 2023/24 Fleet vehicle replacement budget for a used “Roll-On Roll-Off” machine and 3.5T Sweeper.
Reason for decision	<p>The Council operates 3 pieces of plant from the NYGL depot: 2 x shovel loaders and 1 x 360° Grab. The equipment is high cost and, whilst designed to operate in challenging industrial operations, it is designed for specific operations. When used beyond the scope of the intended purpose, this puts unnecessary strain on the machines and ultimately contributes to higher operating and repair costs.</p> <p>There are two specific tasks currently undertaken using the loading shovel that officers would like to instead undertake with 2 pieces of equipment designed for the specific role:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Yard Sweeper Duties2) Movement of material containers
Alternative options considered and rejected	The only other option was to continue to use the machines to carry out functions that they are not designed to do, resulting in the high operating costs.
