Agreed to the capital release request of £115K from the Fire Safety Work stream within the Housing Revenue Account Works to Stock Programme 2024/25 capital budget for the replacement of refuse chute extensions with automatic fire shutter plate at various housing sites.
Reason for decision	The recommendation is to replace the refuse chutes extensions at the premises listed in Appendix A of the confidential report to

meet BS1449-1 and this requires automatic shut off plates to be installed within the refuse chutes.
