Decision	That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation, in conjunction with the Cabinet Member for Corporate Services & Property agreed to:  1. The appointment of PRP Architecture LLP through NHG Development Consultants Framework – Lot 1 to undertake Architectural, Landscape Architect, Public Engagement, Principal Designer and Building Safety Advisor services for the Grays Road Housing Development Project for the value of £337,875; and  2. The capital release request of a total £717,225 from Housing Revenue Account (HRA) capital budgets to enable the appointment of PRP Architecture LLP (£337,875) and additional ancillary consultancy services (£379,350) to support the preparation of a planning application for the Grays Road housing development project.
Reason for decision	This report progresses Cabinet's decision in July 2024 to acquire a large development site in Uxbridge at Grays Road and specialist consultant appointments to support the delivery of development plans for the site. A key objective of this project is
