| Decision | Approved That the Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing and Growth: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Noted the objection received during the statutory consultation on proposals for 'at any time' waiting restrictions at the junction of Lees Road and Uxbridge Road, Uxbridge; and2. Based on discussions with local Ward Councillors, asked that officers organise for the proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions to be implemented at the earliest opportunity. |
| Reason for decision | The proposed 'at any time' waiting restrictions at the junction of Uxbridge Road with Lees Road aim to prevent obstructive parking, which currently causes congestion and safety issues for cyclists, buses, and other vehicles at the junction. These recommendations are in line with the views expressed by the local ward councillors. |
