Reason for decision	This decision supports the planned expansion of Meadow High School, which will increase the number of Special School places for pupils with Moderate Learning Difficulties (MLD) and associated complexities within the Borough.
Alternative options considered and rejected	Not completing the much-needed additional SEND capacity provided by the Meadow High School scheme, at Meadow-Northwood Road site for the start of the September 2026 school year, will increase the reliance on expensive independent Special School places which is an additional revenue expenditure.
