Decision	Approved  That the Leader of the Council, in consultation with Cabinet Members:  1. Subject to satisfactory due diligence, approved the freehold purchase of Paramount House, 33-37 Belmont Road, Uxbridge UB8 1QT at £12,290,000 on terms outlined in this report;  2. Approved the virement of £12,381k from the HRA Unallocated Acquisitions and Development Budget 2025-26 in the Housing Revenue Account (HRA) General Needs New Build Acquisitions Budget 2025-26 to fund the purchase of Paramount House and associated capital release as set out in the report in Appendix C; and authorise officers to submit a bid for GLA funding to support the purchase.  3. Delegated authority to the Corporate Director of Place, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Corporate Services & Property, any other decisions related to this purchase.
