Decision	Approved That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation in conjunction with the Cabinet Member for Corporate Services & Property: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Accepted the tender from HIGHVIEW ROOFING & EXTERNALS LIMITED for the provision of the ROOFING PROGRAMME – PHASE 5 – Ivy House Road, Ickenham UB10 8NG; Church Road, Hayes, UB3 2LJ; and Towers Avenue, Uxbridge UB10 0QQ to the Council for a period of 20 weeks at the value of £220k; and2) Agreed to the release request of £253k inclusive of contingencies and fees from the Roof Renewals work-stream within the Housing Revenue Account Works to Stock programme 2025/26 (as set out in Appendix A of the confidential report).
Reason for decision	The proposed contract is to undertake the planned renewal of roofing to 16 properties, detailed in Appendix C of the

	<p>confidential report. The planned roof renewals will replace roofs that are at the end of their useful life cycle.</p> <p>This is Phase 5 of a phased programme of Roofing Renewals aimed at dealing with replacements and enabling the effective management of smaller packages and reducing costs by use of specialist roofing companies.</p>
Alternative options considered and rejected	Moving away from the larger type of delivery contracts gives greater flexibility. This approach will enable more specialist contractors to deliver installations at lower costs.
