<b>Decision</b>	<b>Approved</b>  <b>That the Cabinet Member for Community &amp; Environment:</b>  <b>1. Approved the six new projects, detailed within the body of the report as part of the asset enhancement programme for 2025/26 and the total allocation of £260k Chrysalis funding for this.</b>  <b>That the Leader of the Council on behalf of the Cabinet Member for Finance &amp; Transformation, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Community &amp; Environment:</b>  <b>2. Agreed to the capital release request of £260k from the 2025/26 Chrysalis Programme budget to fund the six projects detailed within the body of the report (Appendix A of the associated report).</b>
<b>Reason for decision</b>	In January 2025, the Cabinet Member reviewed all applications for Chrysalis funding received from residents, community groups and Ward Councillors and informally

	agreed projects that would greatly improve community assets and resources across the Borough, as well as informally agreeing to fund the improvement of the infrastructure within six parks and open spaces.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	<p>The Cabinet Members could decide not to accept the recommendations and therefore either some or none of the six new projects would be able to proceed. Improvements which have been requested by residents and Ward Councillors cannot then be realised.</p> <p>If the release of capital funds is not approved, the Chrysalis 2025/26 programme cannot be effectively and efficiently progressed as planned and the Chrysalis contribution towards delivery of the Council Strategy 2022-2026 may not be achieved.</p>
