<b>Decision</b>	<b>Approved</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Community and Environment agreed to the following capital release request of £256k from the Leisure Refurbishment programme 2025/26 capital budget for the Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex 3G Football Pitch replacement (Appendix A).
<b>Reason for decision</b>	Completing this work will ensure that the Hillingdon Sports and Leisure Complex continues to operate efficiently, with no loss of service to the 3G astroturf pitch. The works will maintain the safe and effective operation of the facility, ensuring that residents and users can continue to access a high-quality leisure provision without disruption.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Council could choose not to complete the work, but this could result in the Football Foundation reclaiming part of the grant funding issued to the Council. Not completing the work would result in the closure of the pitch and would result in damage to the Council's reputation.
