<b>Decision</b>	<b>Agreed</b>  That the Cabinet Member for Finance & Transformation, in consultation with the Cabinet Member for Corporate Services & Property, agreed to the capital release request of £200k from the 2026/27 Cranford Park Heritage for the completion of heritage works and associated costs at Cranford Park (see Appendix A of the corresponding report).
<b>Reason for decision</b>	The Council must demonstrate that officers have met the conditions of the National Lottery Heritage Funding otherwise it would be liable to pay back the funds received for this project. This includes ensuring that the new café is operational on site.
<b>Alternative options considered and rejected</b>	The Council has entered into an agreement when being awarded funding from the National Lottery Heritage Funding for heritage improvement works at Cranford Park. The Council will need to complete the terms of the agreement within deadlines set.
