Cabinet Members making the decision	Councillor Steve Tuckwell - Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing & Growth
Decision	Agreed The Cabinet Member for Planning, Housing & Growth: 1. Noted the results of the informal consultation for a possible Parking Management Scheme in Cervantes Court, Northwood; and 2. Following discussions with local Ward Councillors and the Cabinet Member, asked that officers prepare a detailed scheme design for a possible Parking Management Scheme in Cervantes Court with the operational times of ‘Monday to Friday 8am to 10am and 2:30pm to 4:30pm’ and conduct a 21-day statutory consultation.
Reason for decision	The recommendations are in line with the views expressed by the local Ward Councillors and seek to address parking issues at Cervantes Court, Northwood. Following a petition from residents, the introduction of a residents’ permit parking scheme is proposed to help manage parking pressures and prevent non-residential parking in the area.
Alternative options considered and rejected	The Council could decide to take no further action.
